

Directions

Place a screen or barrier between two players – so that you can't see what the other is doing.
Select one person to go first and be the speaker. The speaker places some or all of the objects on their image.

 The speaker then gives clear instructions and descriptions in their language as to where they have put each object. For example: The canoe is in the lake. The tent is on the east side of the lake.

4. The listener places the objects on the image where they have understood them to go.

5. When the speaker and listener are finished placing the objects, remove the barrier and

compare the images. Are all the objects in the same place?
