Originally, I wrote these words to teach color concepts in relationship to nature using blue water as a reccurring theme along with an animal's name. This was intended to be a teepee rhyme, however it seemed to be cimpatible with a melody set by 'el maestro'. The repetition and uniformity of the terms used lends itself to easy recall for the children. The strength of this song is in its choice of descriptive colorful animals.
