

This song is all about 'SHARING'. This concept is very much in line with the traditional customs of 'Sharing food from a hunt' till none is left. It is extremely difficult to envision that father kills a moose, mother cooks and everyone is welcome to eat - it is not unusual in a traditional Dene household - it was considered honourable to be in a position to share with everyone - a sign of a good provider/hunter and a good cook.
